Allah ﷻ decided to create. He created stars, moon, sun, planets.

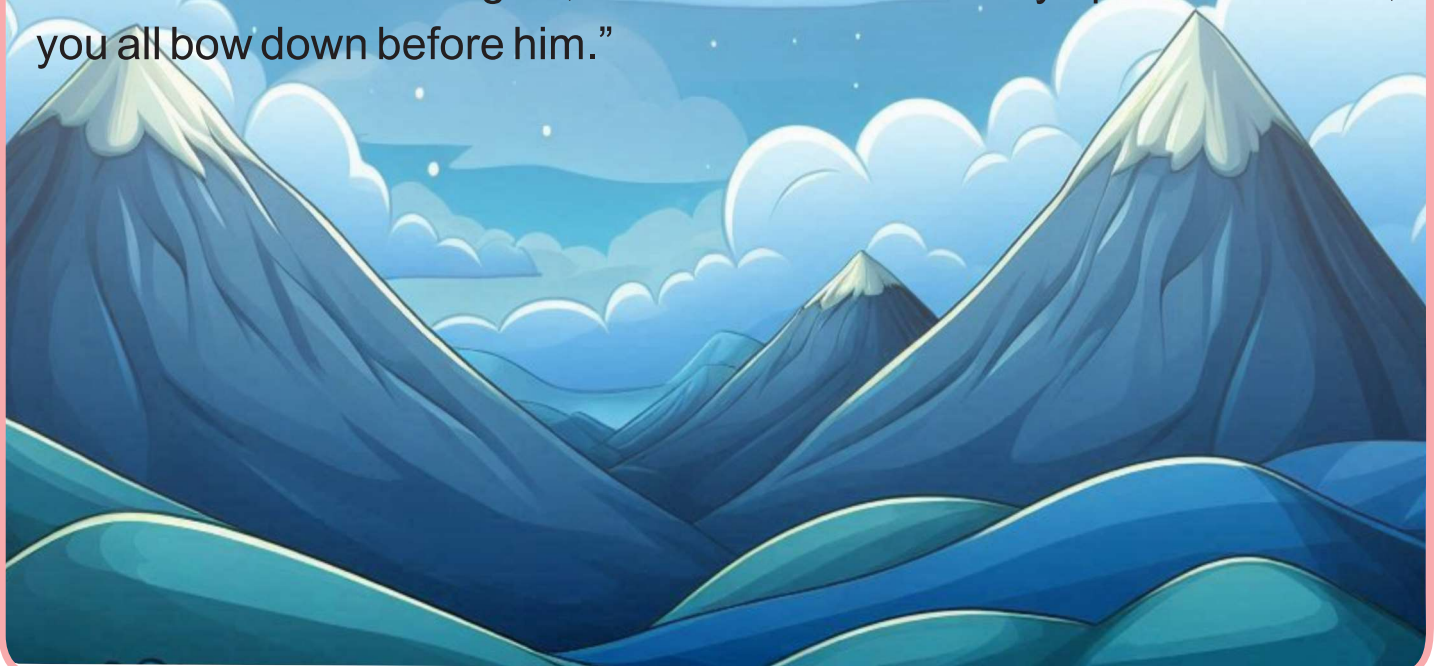
He created Heavens and Earth in six days.

Allah replied, “You are given time till Qayamah. Only disobedient people will follow you and I will fill Hell with such people.”



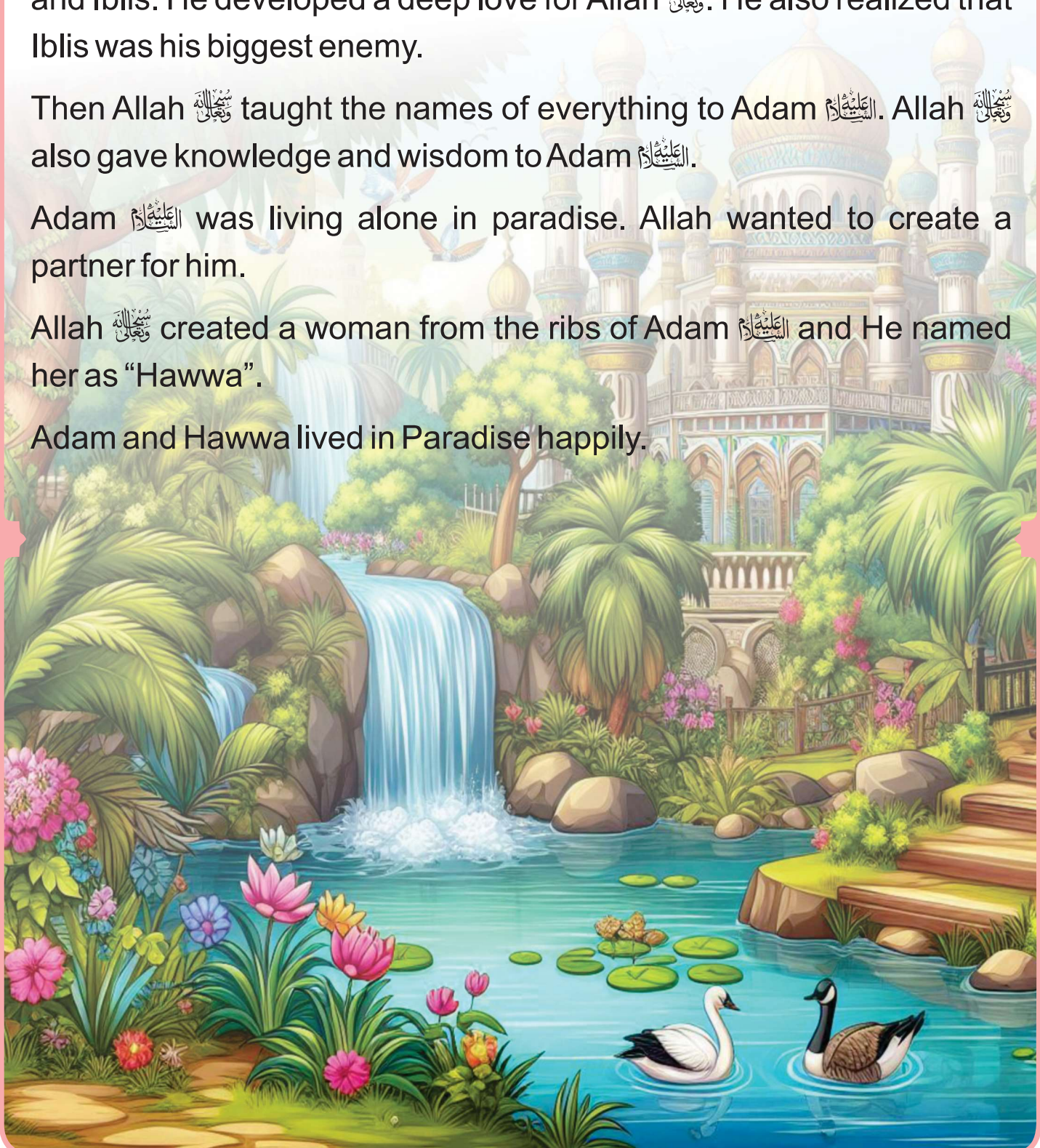
