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Allah is My Lord

We believe that there is only one God, Allah. This belief in one Almighty Allah is called 'Tawheed'.

Tawheed is the foundation of our faith as Muslims. It is the first part of the Shahada, "Ashhadu an la ilaha illallah"—"I bear witness that there is no god but Allah."

He has no children, no father, no mother, no partner. There is no one equal to Him. Allah is the only one worthy of worship.



Allah is our Creator (Khaliq):

Allah is the creator and He is all-powerful. He created the entire universe. He created galaxies, stars, moons, planets. He created the heavens and the Earth. He created angels, humans and Jinn. He created all animals and plants. It is only Allah who created everything.

Allah is Ar-Rahman and Ar-Raheem (The Most Gracious and The Most Merciful):

One of the most beautiful names of Allah is "The Most Gracious" (Ar-Rahman) and "The Most Merciful" (Ar-Raheem).

Allah # has given us a lot of blessings.

He provides us with food to eat and water to drink. How does a large tree grow from a tiny seed? How does the sun give us light and energy? How do we breathe air into our lungs? Who has placed love in the hearts of our parents?

Allah has made us Muslims. He has given us the Quran for Guidance. He sent Prophet Muhammad to show the true path. These are some of the blessings of Allah upon us.

Allah is The Most Forgiving (Al-Ghafoor):

In Arabic, *Ghafoor means* "The Most Forgiving." This tells us that Allah is always ready to forgive us, no matter what mistakes we make. Everyone makes mistakes sometimes. It's a part of being human! But when we realize we have done something wrong and say sorry, Allah forgives us.

Allah wants us to be forgiving as well. We can practice forgiveness by:

Saying Sorry:

When we do something wrong, we should say sorry and mean it.

Forgiving Others:

When someone makes a mistake, we should try to forgive them quickly.

Helping Each Other:

We can help friends and family learn from their mistakes, just like Allah helps us.





How to Strengthen Our Faith in Allah

- 1. Praying (Salah): One of the most important ways to show our faith in Allah is by praying. We pray five times a day to connect with Allah, thank him, and ask for His help. When we pray, we feel closer to Him.
- 2. Reading the Quran: By reading and understanding the Quran, we learn about Allah's teachings and how to live a good life.
- 3. Remembering Allah (Dhikr): We can strengthen our faith by remembering Allah throughout the day. This can be done by saying phrases like "SubhanAllah" (Glory be to Allah), "Alhamdulillah" (Praise be to Allah), and "Allahu Akbar" (Allah is the Greatest). These words help us to connect with Allah.
- **4. Making Dua (Supplication)**: We can talk to Allah and ask Him for help in our daily lives.
- **5. Doing Good Deeds**: Helping others, being kind and following the teachings of Islam are ways to show our faith in Allah.


